MK GATEWAY



MTT is delighted to be part of the team delivering MK Gateway in Milton Keynes. Situated minutes from the £150m Santander Digital Hub and the proposed new MK:University, MK Gateway will be a new mixed-use scheme destination designed by internationally renowned architects, Rogers Stirk Harbour and Partners (RSHP).

An existing 1980's office building will be transformed by adding 3 new floors and a full refurbishment, resulting in 220,000ft² of grade A office space. This will be complimented with approximately 280 BTR homes, public realm (with unique space for events and cultural/community use), alongside food, leisure and retail outlets to create a vibrant environment.

CAMDEN GOODS YARD

Continuing our long association with Berkeley Group, MTT is thrilled to be part of St George's team delivering Camden Goods Yard.

This new 8 acre development located between Camden Town and Primrose Hill is a residential led mixed-use scheme, comprising seven residential blocks, 100,000ft² of commercial office and retail spaces - including a new supermarket.

We are also delighted to be working with SWAP Architects on this residential led, mixed-use scheme in the heart of Basildon.

The goal is to return the town centre to the social hub it was in the 1950's. This development will play an important part in refreshing the town centre and will act as the catalyst for wider regeneration.

The development will provide 500 BTR homes, a community health facility and incubator space for SME's. The goal is to diversify the housing offer and to encourage and nurture talent retention in Basildon.

...MTT/COVID-19 review - continued

In our July newsletter, we referred to our 'COVID-19 and Beyond' paper to explore the way ahead and to stimulate debate regarding what will be important to end users in the wake of the current situation.

As we said, the paper dealt with things in a practical and logical manner, and following the completion of many bespoke building studies carried out off the back of the original paper, we are now seeing proposals being implemented.

The Covid-19 situation is new, but the Wellness issue is not. The pandemic has heightened, not just developers' and their professional teams' awareness to this important point, but now most people have an opinion or need to satisfy their anxieties. It is now right at the top of the agenda.

Our reviews look at the occupiers' experience within the building and where the occupier interacts with the building, or could be affected by the environment within the workspace and associated areas.

Where improvements can be made to the existing provisions, they are identified and recommendations made with regards to any remedial works required.

...MTT/COVID-19 & LIFTS

More specifically, the lift industry has responded positively to the Covid-19 pandemic with new technology and innovations for contactless systems and enhanced lift car controls and ventilation.

The BCO has also issued guidance on lift design, including destination control systems operated from security barriers or card reader systems. One of the great advantages of destination systems is that people wait in front of the designated lift, rather than mingling in large groups.

Contactless systems such as mobile phones with QR codes provided by building management systems are also being suggested for both tenants and visitors.



On a practical note; durable, easily cleaned finishes should also be considered for new lift cars, landing entrances, pushes and indicators to reduce the effects of frequent cleaning with chemicals or abrasion.
